## **IDENTIFY COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT EARLY**

Medicare recommends individuals aged 65 and older undergo yearly screenings for cognitive impairment. Younger adults experiencing concerns or symptoms should also be screened. It takes about 30 minutes and trained staff perform the screenings. The results are available immediately to share with your primary care provider.
